

Open Spaces in BERLIN GLOBAL

“Ground rules” for working together

Introduction

These “ground rules” serve as a basis for collaborative projects on the Open Spaces of BERLIN GLOBAL. The details of each project will be protocolled in an Open Space contract.

Rules

- 1) As a foundation for respectful cooperation that is sensitive to discrimination, both parties will cultivate open, clear and trustful communication with each other. This should enable all parties to address and resolve any conflicts or misunderstandings together.
- 2) The form of each individual collaboration between the Stiftung Stadtmuseum Berlin and its cooperation partners will be agreed upon before the project begins, along with the degree and scope of active support by the Stadtmuseum Berlin.
- 3) As creators of the Open Space, the cooperation partners have the final say on all content of the exhibition, provided it adheres to the following guidelines:
 - a. It does not contain any insults; obscenities; personal attacks; glorification of violence; or content that is racist, antisemitic, Islamophobic, homophobic, sexist or discriminatory or defamatory in any other way.
 - b. It does not follow any commercial aims, does not contain party political campaigns, and is not centred on the self-promotion of organised groups.
 - c. It has been researched to the best knowledge and ability of the cooperation partners.
- 4) Should these points be violated during the working process and a solution not be found, including with the help of a third-party mediator, the Stadtmuseum Berlin reserves the right to end the cooperation.
- 5) The Stadtmuseum Berlin may comment on or distance itself from content of the Open Space project.

Upon signing the Open Space contract, both parties commit to respecting these basic principles.
